THE DENNIS GOODELL COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP

Dennis Goodell was a 1992 graduate of Garces High School. While at Garces he was a four-sport athlete (football, soccer, basketball, and baseball) and involved in various clubs. Dennis went on to attend Cal Poly, San Luis Obispo where he graduated in 1996 with a degree in Ag-Business. In April of 1997, Dennis was hired by Ewing Irrigation as a Marketing Representative. After proving himself, a year and a half later, he was named Manager of Ewing's Bakersfield Branch. He was the youngest manager in the history of the company.

Dennis passed away in September of 1999 while trying to save his beloved dog "Yellow" from drowning in an irrigation canal. Dennis believed that a college education was the key to success. This scholarship has been formed in his memory to give others the chance to succeed.


